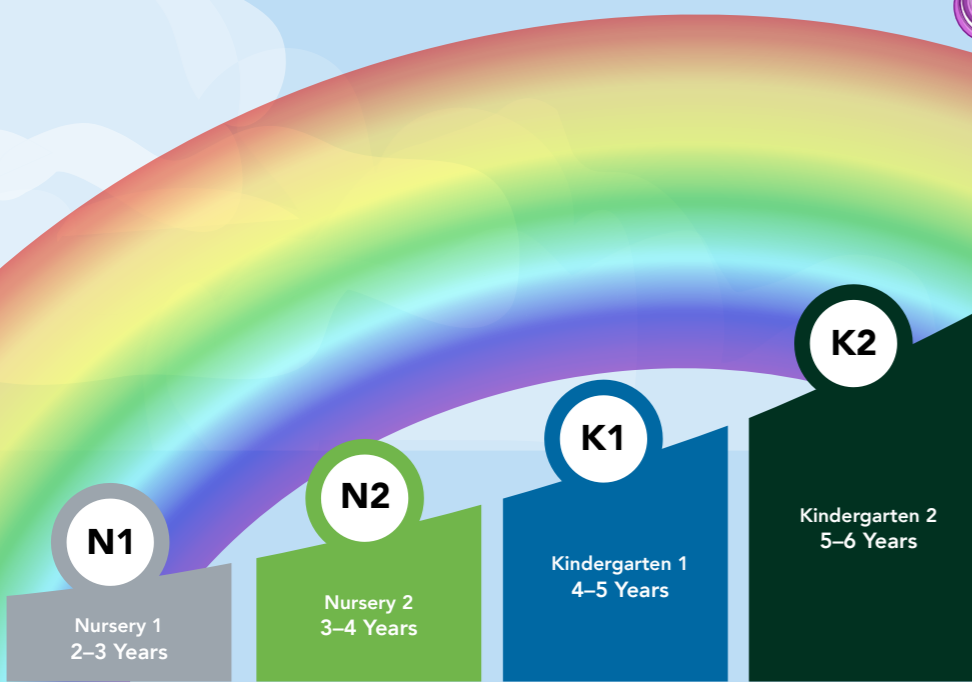
## Tzu Chi Foundation History

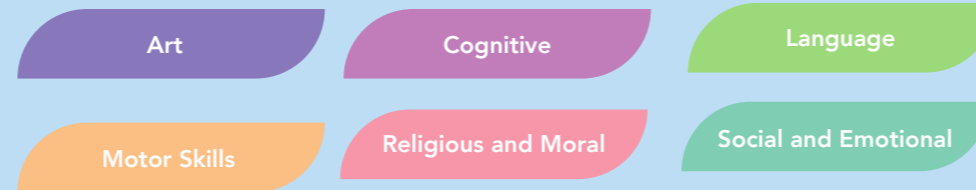
## Early Childhood's Profile

## Early Childhood Curriculum

The National Curriculum integrated with Ren Wen Program (Humanistic Education), is designed to develop the child holistically through activities focusing on 6 aspects of learning:

 Through Jing Si Aphorism—themes such as politeness, responsibility, respect, filial piety, courage, compassion, contentment, and gratefulness are introduced to students. Another important aspect of Ren Wen curriculum is the teaching of daily life skills, which allows students to practise on how to look after themselves and the environment.
- Flower Arrangement and Tea Ceremony**  
 Flower Arrangement classes aim to build awareness and appreciation for the environment. Students learn to emulate the beauty of flowers by maintaining their proper posture with a clean and neat appearance.
