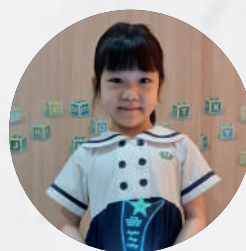

Webinar Parenting

Pada akhir semester dua ini, sekolah menggelar dua sesi webinar. Pada tanggal 31 Maret 2021 dan 21 April 2021.

dr. Suryadi Susanto, SpA sebagai pemateri pertama berbagi tips kapan saat yang tepat untuk berkonsultasi. Dokter memaparkan petunjuk praktis tumbuh kembang seorang anak. Ada dua aspek yang perlu cermati orang tua dari buah hati. Kondisi perubahan fisiknya (tumbuh) dan perkembangan yang terpantau dari fungsi organ tubuh serta kemampuan struktur jasmaninya yang lebih kompleks (kembang)

Biasanya, pertumbuhan dan perkembangan anak berada pada fase paling pesat antara usia nol hingga tiga tahun. Pada periode ini, si kecil membutuhkan asupan gizi dan nutrisi

yang mencukupi agar tumbuh kembangnya menjadi lebih optimal. Pada tahapan tumbuh kembang anak, pertumbuhan dan perkembangan yang baik tentu berpengaruh pada hidup anak di masa mendatang.

Pertumbuhan anak adalah segala sesuatu yang dapat diukur, yaitu meliputi tinggi badan, berat badan dan lingkar kepala. Sedangkan perkembangan anak yaitu bertambahnya kemampuan fungsi-fungsi individu (motorik kasar, motorik halus, pendengaran, penglihatan, komunikasi, emosi sosial, kemandirian, intelegensia, dan moral).

Selain itu terdapat faktor penentu tumbuh kembang anak: faktor intrinsik (keluarga) dan faktor ekstrinsik (lingkungan).

Webinar kedua yaitu: “Super parents; Excellent kids,” adalah topik perbincangan seru yang melibatkan orang tua murid. Menghadirkan Ibu Linna Huang dan Ibu Lidiana Bunyamin sebagai panelis. Ibu ling Felicia Joe dan Bapak Andrias Wijaya memoderatori diskusi berdurasi 60 menit ini.

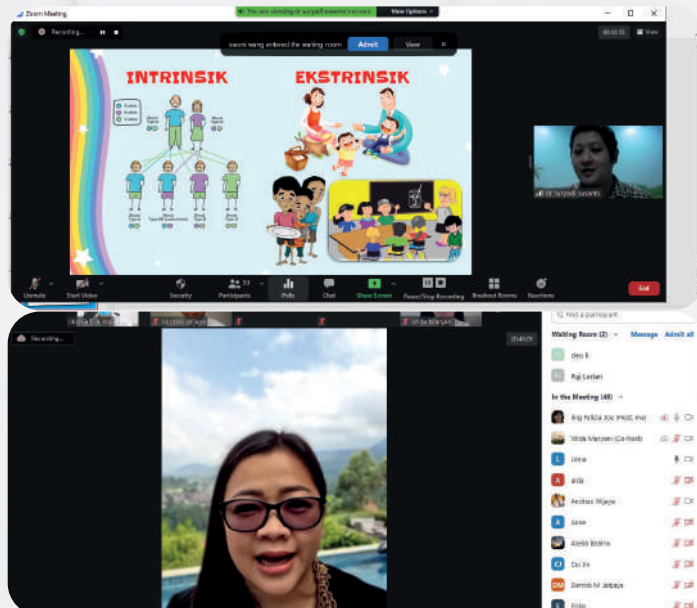
Kedua narasumber sepekat benang merah yang menjadi kunci utama adalah memupuk dan menanamkan rasa kepercayaan diri anak. Dikatakan anak akan berkarya bila diberikan pendampingan dan motivasi pada setiap kesempatan. Talenta anakpun tebersit secara diam-diam.

Bersabar tatkala anak gagal ataupun lama menyudahi hal yang belum dipahami. Bila sang anak tidak berhasil atau menyerah, orang tua dapat memberikan pengarahan agar anak dapat mencoba menyelesaikan kegiatan itu. Apresiasi atau rewards - “Kamu hebat! atau memberikan tepukan di pundak anak” boleh diberikan sekiranya anak

menyelesaikan tugas yang diembannya. Dalam hal mendidik anak, perlu diketahui adanya segitiga kehidupan dimana anak, orang tua dan guru serta lingkungan di sekitarnya sama-sama berperan penting dalam pertumbuhan karakter anak.

“Apabila suatu saat ketika anak bosan penting bagi orang tua untuk mengajak anak bermain dan mengingatkan bahwa mereka punya bakat yang mungkin saja tidak dimiliki setiap anak, jadi anak akan lebih bersyukur. Dalam mendidik anak tidak hanya memprioritaskan bahwa anak harus pintar saja akan tetapi orang tua dapat menanamkan pendidikan moral kepada anak. Mengajarkan tata karma melalui ucapan maupun berperilaku, serta memberitahu anak, apa yang baik dan yang buruk.” Demikian pesan akhir dari kedua ibu Kartini abad dua puluh satu diakhir Tzu Chi Talks.

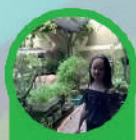

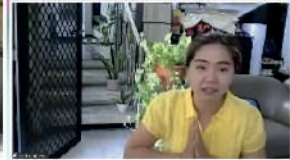

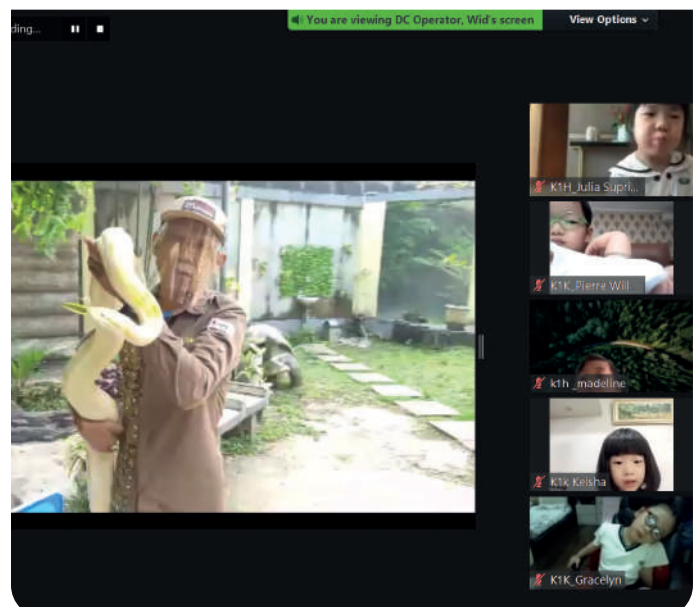
Virtual Field Trip

However, during this pandemic, exploring the surroundings might be risky, and the safety and well-being of our students are our top priorities. So this year, we are adapting to the situation and came up with the idea of a virtual field trip, where children still can explore their surroundings but not be exposed to the risk.

Together with Dream Creators, we tailored a brand new method to “explore” the surroundings while keeping safe at home. The activity kits were prepared and sent

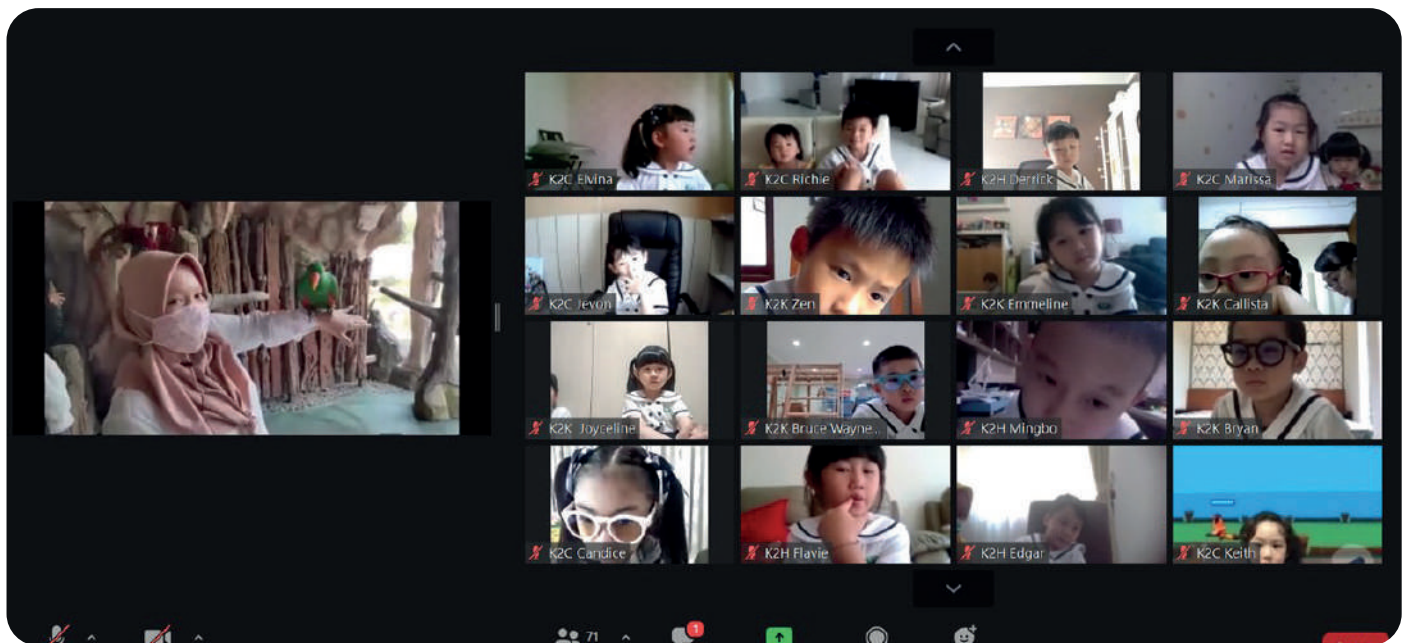
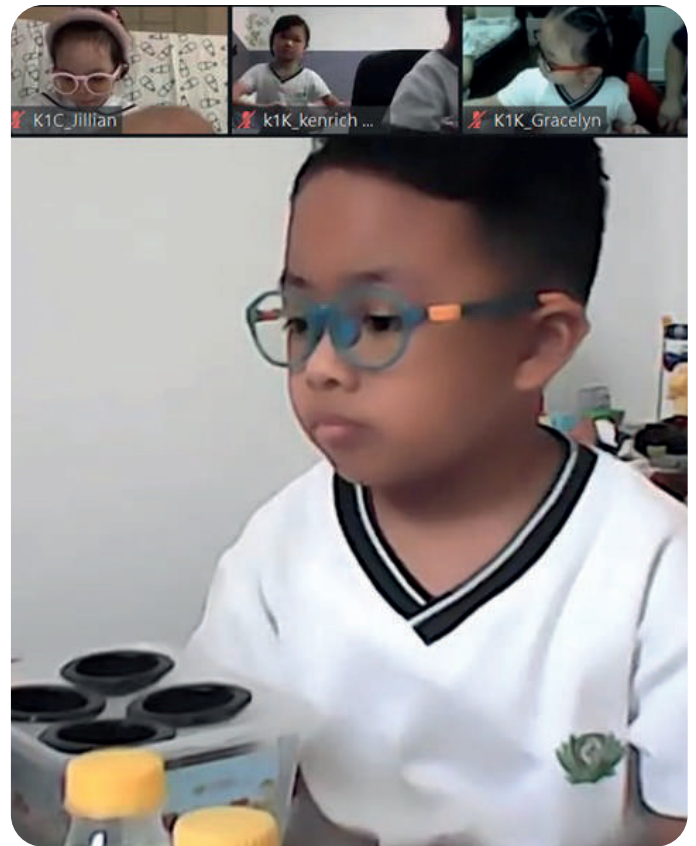

how to care for them. Nursery level students planted bean sprouts and observed their growth, while Kindergarten level students made a hydroponic kangkung plant.

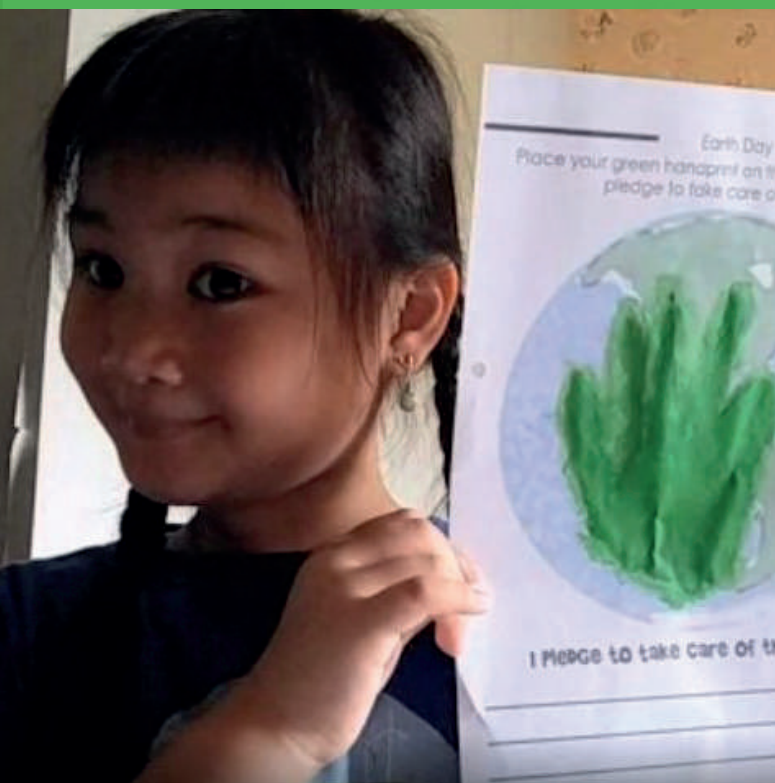

The nursery students were encouraged to color their DIY bags. It was a fun day for all of us!

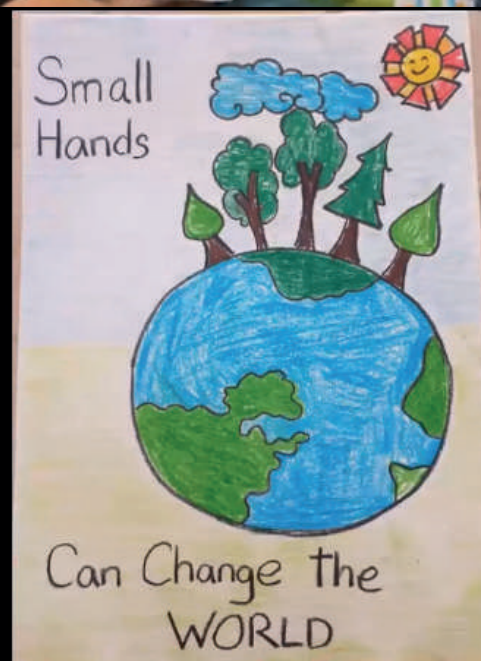

In April 2021, the Early Childhood Department hosted our first kindergarten virtual competition with the theme: Love Yourself, Love Nature. There were 167 students from 21 schools, including schools from outside Jabodetabek, who participated in this event.

茶道礼仪之美



受疫情影响，本学年慈济幼儿园所有的课程均采取线上教学模式，对于茶道课程而言，接受着前所未有的严峻考验。人文老师们在一次次的模拟课堂与实践，调整着教学方法，让学生们即使有电脑荧幕的阻隔也能时刻保持对茶道课程的热情。

老师们根据学生的年龄段，设计不同的教学风格。小班学生的茶道课程融入了更多的游戏互动，学生们在游戏中学习各项礼仪。其中就有带学生学习【行如风】，老师播放音乐，带学生跟随音乐节奏的快慢，来调节走路的步调，当老师将音乐暂停时，学生就要立即停下脚步。老师也不忘

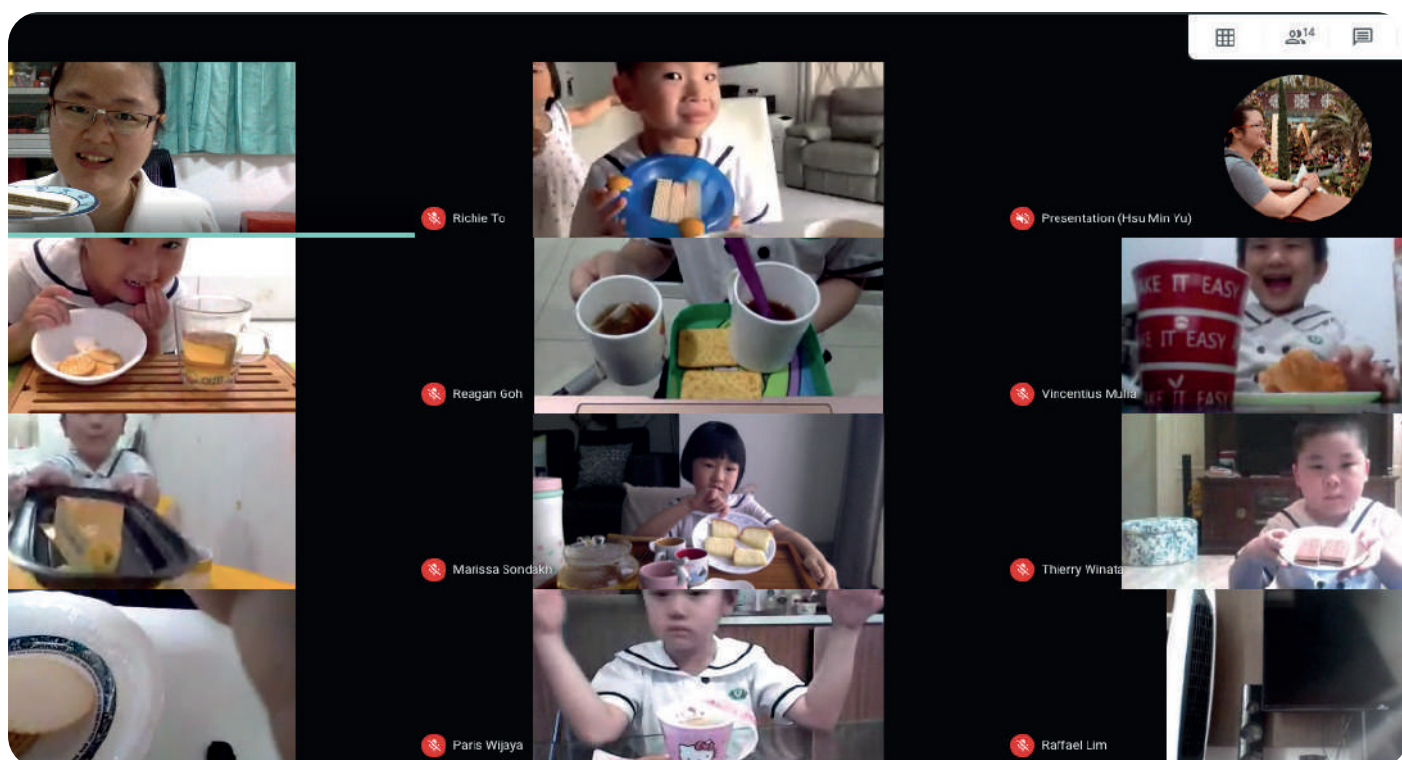
时刻提醒学生走路要轻，正如师公上人所说“走路要轻轻的，不要伤害大地。”。最后一个知识点，才是教学生奉茶。双手捧着茶盏，随着音乐的节奏，轻轻地走到爸爸妈妈的面前，将茶恭敬地奉给父母，举手投足间，无不体现着茶道的礼仪之美。

幼儿园大班，则深入介绍了每种茶品，如红茶和绿茶等，教学生如何通过茶汤的颜色，来辨别茶的品种。因为线上课程，老师无法泡茶给学生品尝，所以换成教学生自己用茶包来泡茶，通过品尝茶的味道来辨别其品种。学生们第一次尝试自己泡茶喝，喜悦之情溢于言表。除泡茶外，大班

的学生也开始着手学习准备茶点了，其中一次的茶点是吐司，学生将吐司涂上自己喜欢的果酱，或用果酱在吐司上画出喜欢的图案，再以红茶配之。最后将自制的茶点与茶汤，怀着感恩的心，双手奉给父母，邀请父母一起享用。

在茶道课程中，学生们不仅学会了分辨茶的品种，泡茶，与制作茶点，通过茶道的礼仪，更培养了学生爱惜大地，尊重与感恩父母的好品德。

Moving Up Activity and K1-K2 Handover

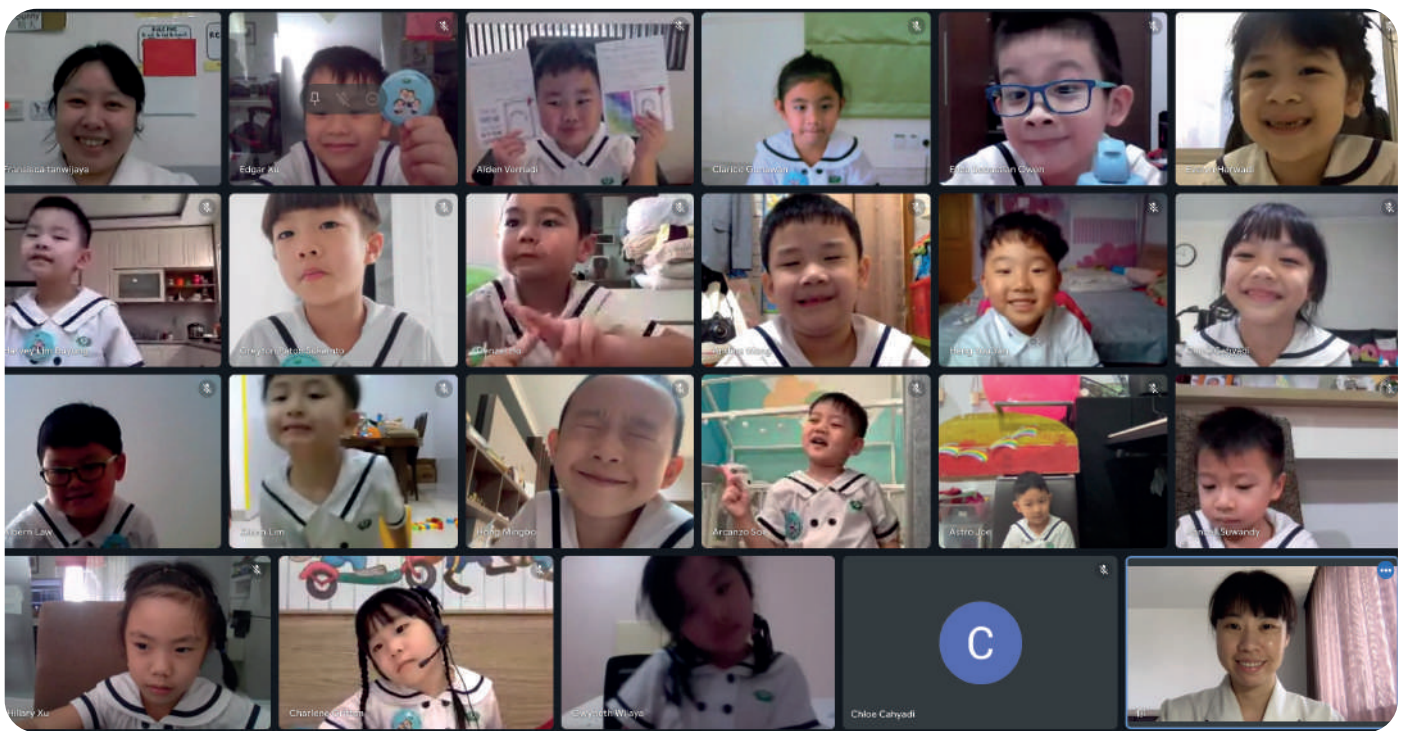

K1-K2 classes continued with another memorable event which is the Handover

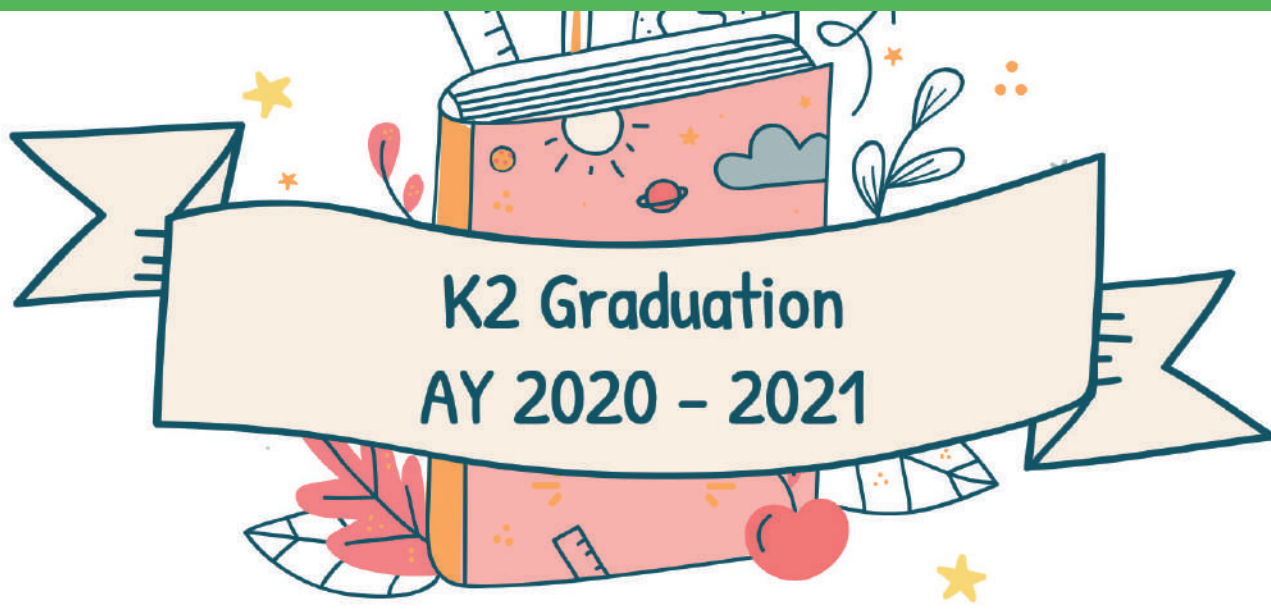

Family Fitness Challenge

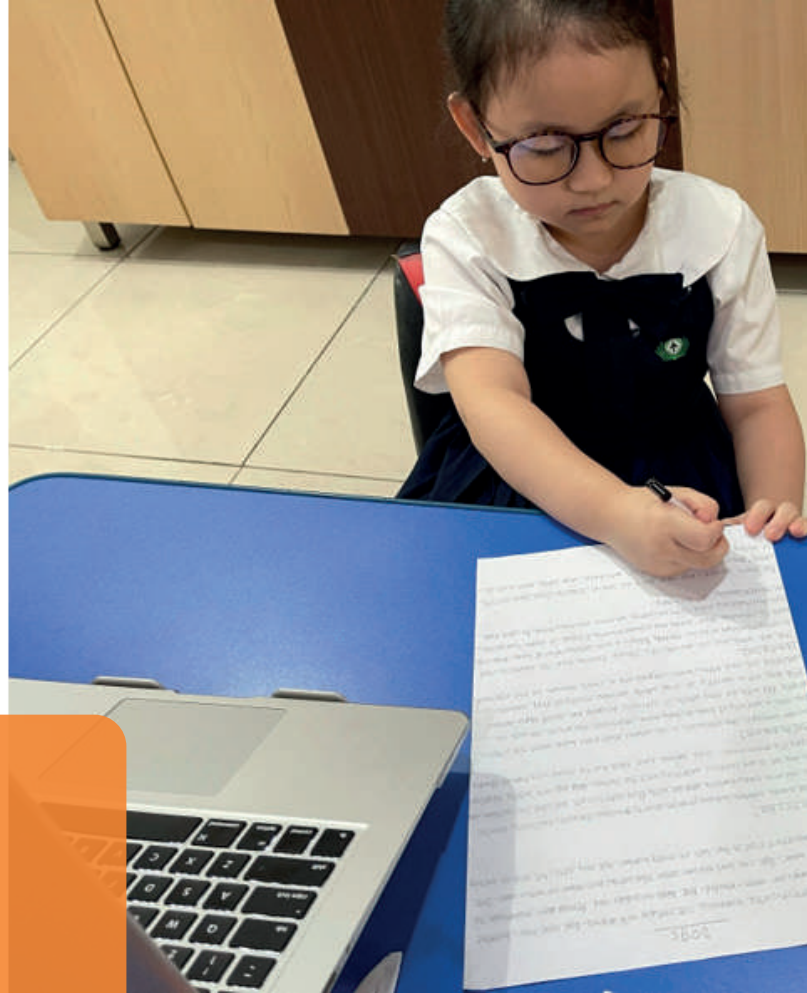
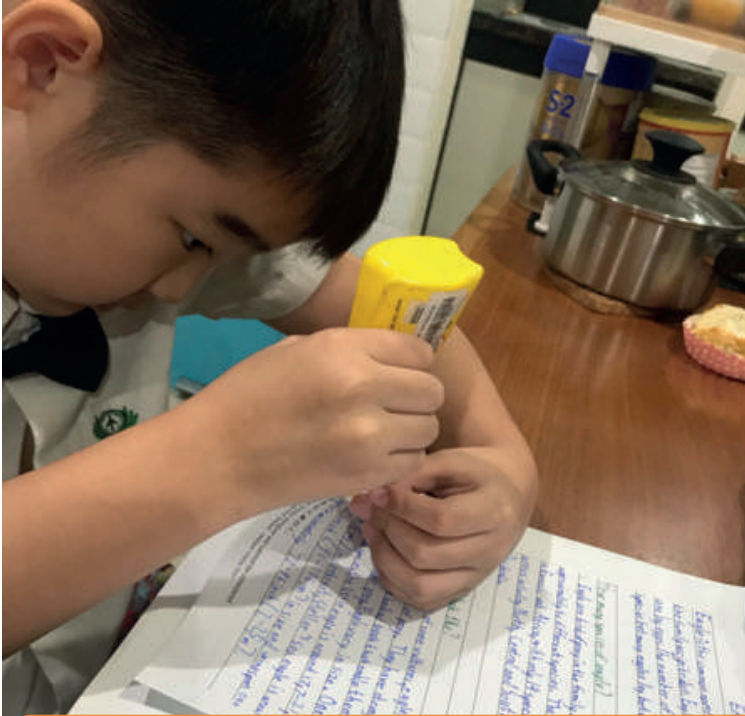

Be a S.T.A.R. Becoming a Lifelong Learner

It is said that readers are lifelong learners and leaders. Intellectual, emotional and social growth and pleasure are just a few of the benefits of pleasure reading. At Tzu Chi Primary School, students are encouraged and inspired to make it a habit to read for fun in and out of class.

Spearheaded by the English Department, the Reading Log Program called **“Be a S.T.A.R.!” — Super Talented, Able Reader** - was started this school year. The goal of the program is simple: to make reading one of the strong habits of primary students. For three terms, English teachers in each level provided students with online reading

materials, giving them access to a variety of texts that were both educational and enjoyable. After reading a text of their choice, students freely expressed their learning, feelings or insights about what they had read. For young readers, they wrote whether they had read on their own or with their family members. The Reading Logs were often monitored to ensure consistency, and students received recognition for reading habitually.

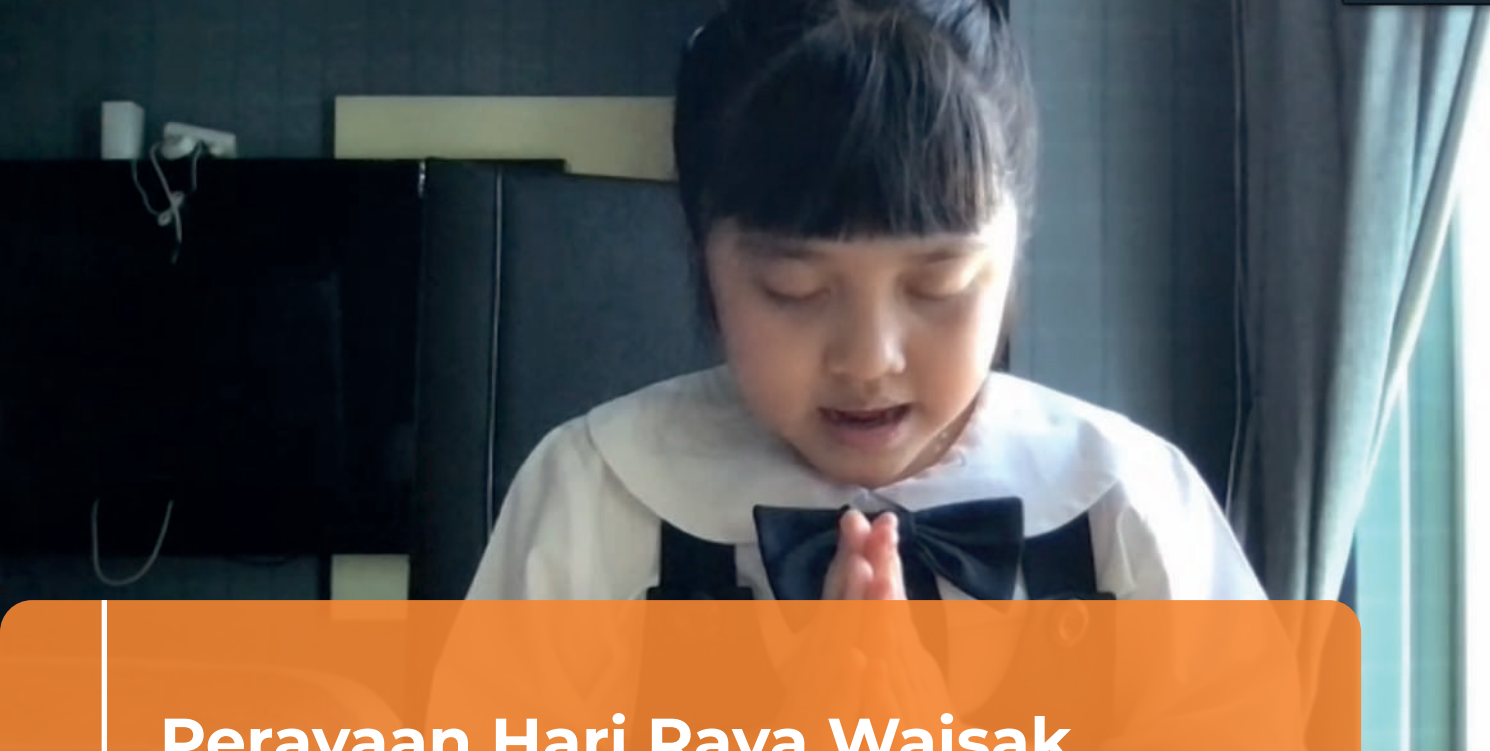
With all the positive feedback on “Be a S.T.A.R.” from both students and parents, the school had decided to extend the initiative to Indonesian Language and

Chinese Language Departments. In doing so, students were immersed in assorted texts in two other languages. This gave them more opportunities to make enjoyable reading choices.

Tzu Chi Primary School believes that good readers are strong learners. By instilling the habit of leisure reading, they become knowledgeable, open-minded, and caring individuals. And this indeed makes them a S.T.A.R.!

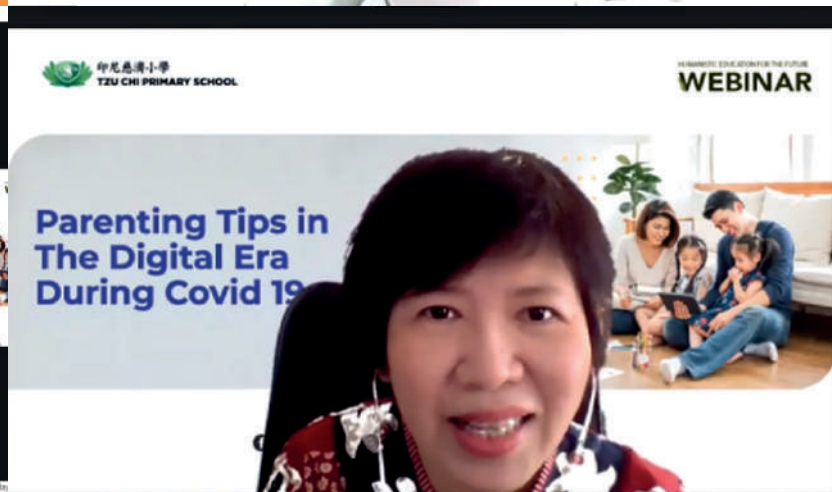
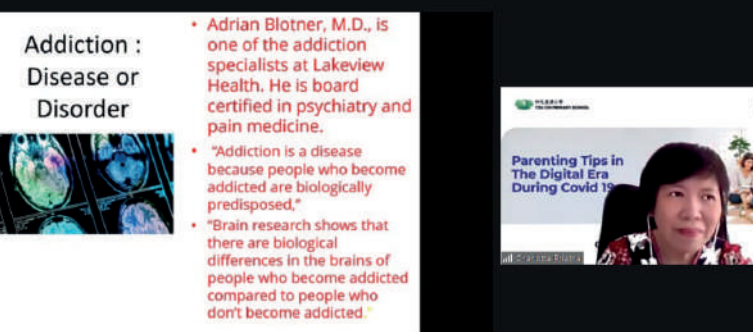
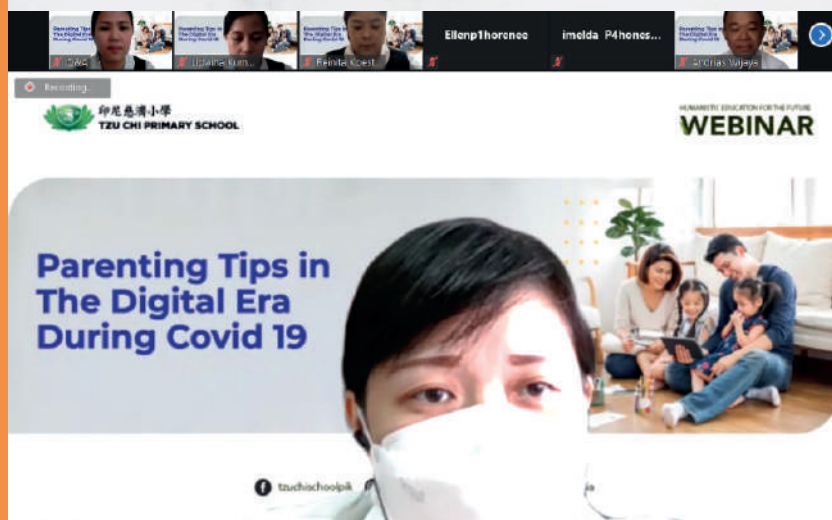
Parent Webinar Parenting Tips in the Digital Era During Covid-19

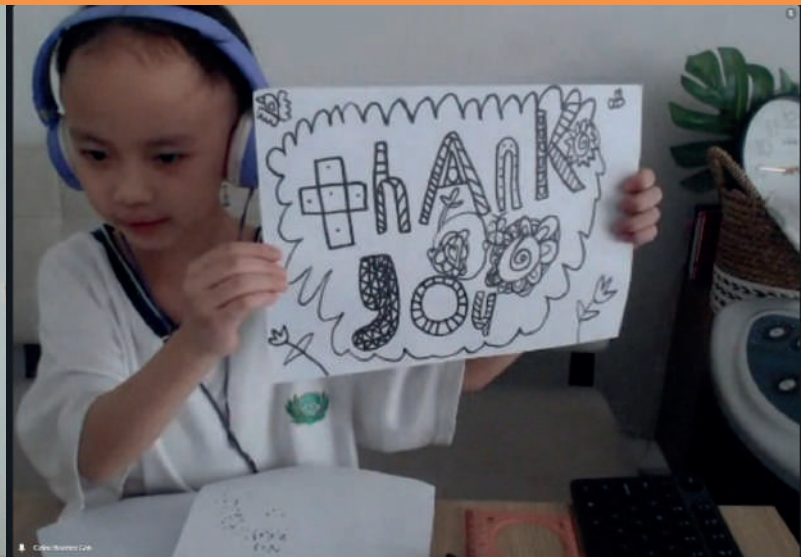

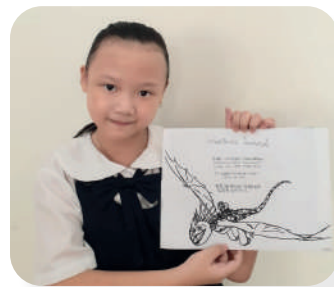


期末感恩活动

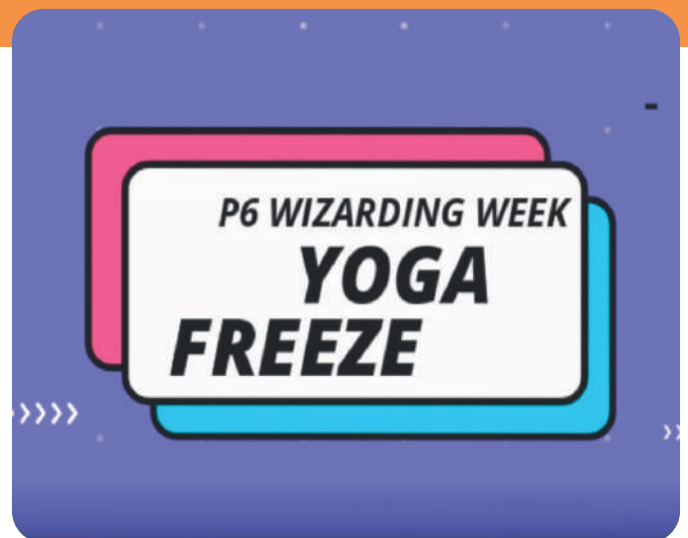


Primary 6 Magical Send-off to Graduates

Secondary Learning Centre Juara II Lomba Perpustakaan Tingkat Provinsi



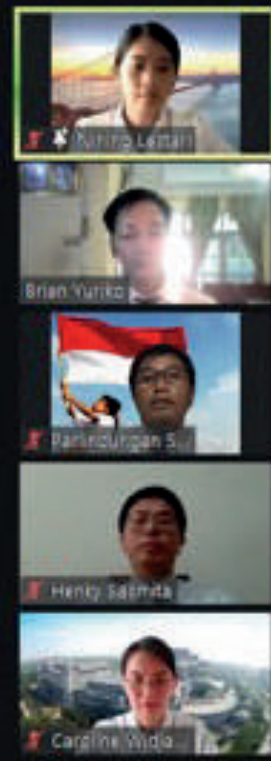

Suci tersebut seluruh peserta beranjali (merangkapkan kedua tangannya di depan dada).

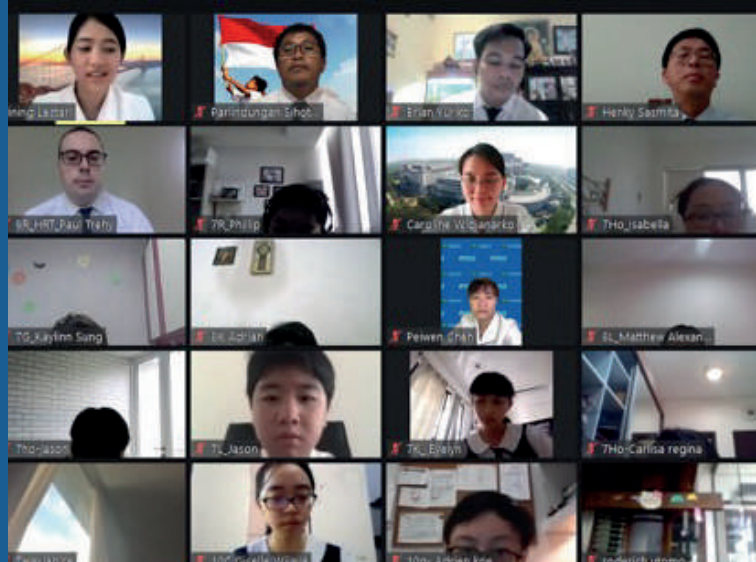
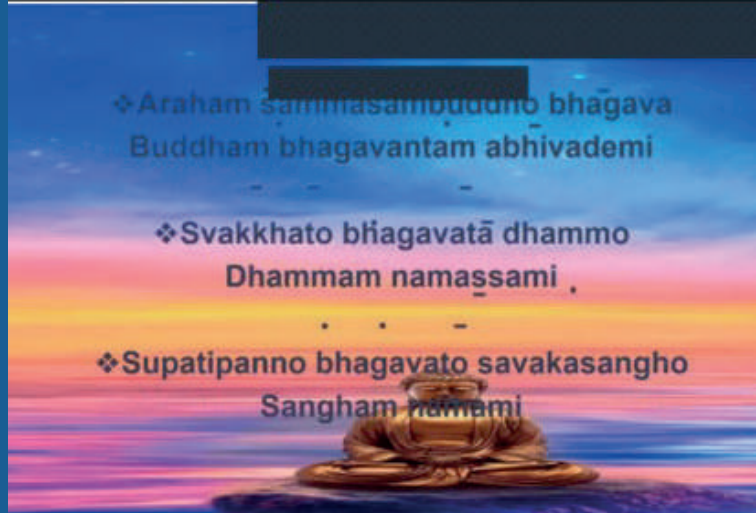

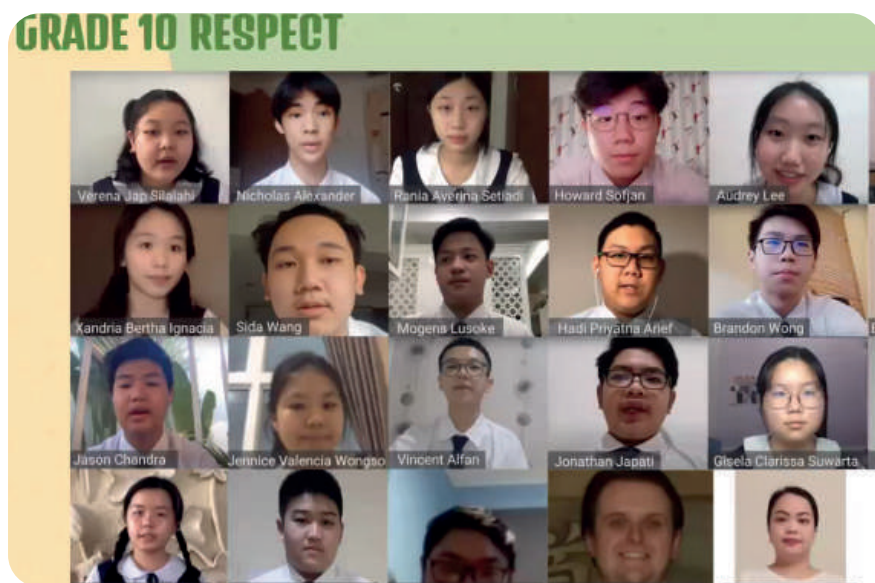
During the celebration, three students were given Best in Service as Action awards, another two students received Tzu Chi Character awards and finally, six students received overall Academic Excellence awards.
