Webinar: Batuk dan Bahaya yang Ditimbulkan

“Batuk dan Bahaya yang Ditimbulkan” adalah tema kesehatan yang diadakan pada 22 Oktober. Kami mengundang dr. Natasja Rosamunde Kandau, Sp.P sebagai pemateri. Dokter lulusan fakultas kedokteran UI ini adalah dokter spesialis paru di Tzu Chi Hospital, Pantai Indah Kapuk.

Menurutnya ada 2 jenis batuk yang harus dicermati:

■ Batuk Akut

Jenis batuk yang paling ringan. Hanya berlangsung selama kurang dari dua minggu dan dapat hilang dengan sendirinya.

■ Batuk Kronis

Batuk yang berlangsung lebih dari delapan minggu dan bisa menjadi tanda penyakit paru-paru yang serius.

Batuk adalah respon alami dari tubuh sebagai sistem pertahanan untuk mengeluarkan sejumlah volume udara secara mendadak dari rongga toraks melalui epiglottis dan mulut. Melalui mekanisme tersebut, aliran udara yang dihasilkan dengan sangat cepat dapat melontarkan material yang ada di sepanjang saluran pernapasan, terutama saluran yang besar.

Batuk adalah refleks spontan yang penting untuk membantu melindungi jalan napas dan paru-paru dari iritasi (seperti refleks bersin, refleks berkedip).

Batuk sesekali adalah normal karena membantu membersihkan tenggorokan dan saluran napas dari kuman, lendir, dan debu. Tetapi batuk yang tidak kunjung hilang atau

disertai gejala lain seperti sesak napas, produksi lendir, atau dahak berdarah bisa menjadi tanda masalah medis yang lebih serius.

Segeralah memeriksakan diri ke dokter bilamana batuk berkepanjangan.

Hybrid Learning

It has been almost 2 years since WHO announced the status of the COVID-19 pandemic. All non-essential sectors have to be on hold or done online, including the learning activities at school. However, since the positive case of Covid-19 in Indonesia is decreasing, the government, through the minister of education, gave a green light for schools to reopen. The scenario offered by the government is to have hybrid learning, a combination of online and offline learning. Tzu Chi School is one of the schools that conducts hybrid learning. After several months of distance learning for this academic year, children were finally able to return to school on October 18, 2021 by following the strict health protocols, such as wearing masks in the school premises, checking the body temperature of all students and teachers, washing hands, using a hand



sanitizer, setting distance for students' tables in the classroom and limiting the number of students in each classroom.

Hybrid learning combines face-to-face learning at school with online learning at home to give all students the opportunity to experience the learning process. For now, the students who attend the offline class go to school once a week to have the lesson for an hour.

In Tzu Chi School, hybrid learning started at the K2 Level, followed by the K1 Level the following week. N2 Level students returned to school a week later and the last level was the N1 Level students.

When the students returned to school for the first time, they were so excited. They were happy to see their teachers and meet their friends in person. In the class, teachers


always encourage and remind the students to follow the health protocols to ensure the safety of both students and the teachers.

Hopefully, with the pandemic situation getting better, schools will return to normal.








Membangun Komunikasi Antara Orang Tua dan Anak

Komunikasi adalah salah satu faktor yang sangat penting dalam pertumbuhan dan perkembangan anak-anak sejak usia dini. Anak-anak yang memiliki komunikasi yang hangat dan aman dengan orang tuanya baik secara afirmatif, emosional maupun fisik akan siap bertumbuh dengan sehat, dapat beradaptasi dengan lingkungan yang baru, serta mampu bereksplorasi dengan rasa aman dan mandiri.

Komunikasi dalam tumbuh-kembang anak sangat erat kaitannya dengan pola kelekatan/kedekatan anak dan orang tuanya. Teori tentang pola relasi kedekatan (attachment) ini diteliti dan dicetuskan oleh Mary Ainsworth. Ia mengatakan ada 4 pola kedekatan hubungan antara orang tua dan anak yaitu: secure, anxious-ambivalent,



anxious-avoidant, dan anxious disorganised. Anak-anak yang memiliki pola hubungan yang secure atau aman dengan orang tuanya akan tumbuh menjadi anak yang sehat dalam gambar dirinya, aspek sosialnya, kemandirian, dan karyanya.

Seorang anak dengan usia 2 tahun yang memiliki komunikasi dan hubungan emosional yang hangat, nyaman dan aman dengan orang tuanya akan tumbuh menjadi

anak yang memiliki percaya diri yang positif, dapat bersosialisasi dengan teman-teman yang baru, dan akan siap untuk belajar dan bereksplorasi dengan keceriaan. Ia pun akan memiliki gambar diri yang sehat tentang dirinya di kemudian hari untuk melanjutkan studinya dan berkarir di masa depannya.

Tidak sedikit anak-anak yang mengalami kesulitan dalam kemandirian dan beradaptasi dengan lingkungan pembelajaran yang baru. Ada yang menolak, ada yang takut, dan ada pula yang menangis. Agar anak-anak dapat tumbuh mandiri dan memiliki gambar diri yang positif tentang dirinya, orang tua sejak dini sudah dapat melakukan 5 bahasa kasih kepada anak-anaknya.

Menurut Gary Chapman, 5 bahasa kasih itu adalah: sentuhan fisik yang hangat, kata-

kata afirmasi yang menguatkan, waktu bersama yang berkualitas seperti bermain bersama, memberikan hadiah pada waktu yang tepat, dan juga melakukan tindakan konkrit melayani dan membantu anak.

Topik ini kami angkat pada webinar yang diadakan bulan Agustus 2021 dengan Ms. Nina Sunandar sebagai moderator.

印尼幼儿华语教学线上讲座

二〇二一年十一月八日，印尼慈济幼儿园受台湾慈济大学邀请，开设了一堂以《印尼幼儿华语教学》为主题的线上讲座。

讲座由印尼慈济幼儿园华文部主任吕闻娜主讲，前来参加讲座的皆为台湾慈济大学不同科系的在读生，有来自马来西亚的学生，有来自台湾的学生，有来自越南的学生，还有印尼在台的留学生。印尼慈济幼儿园园长游翌瑛女士，人文部主任韩蓉蓉老师也出席了当天的讲座。

整场讲座分为四大部分，首先以介绍印尼幼儿园的总数量以及各个省份幼儿园的分布图来进入今天的主题。

据2020-2021学年统计，仅雅加达就有9158所幼儿园，其中公立幼儿园474所，无华语教学；私立幼儿园8684所，私立幼儿园里面只有通过国际学校资质认证的才可以加入华语教学。

第二部分是游览印尼慈济幼儿园，以展示图片的方式来带慈大学生了解一下印尼幼儿园的环境，园内的教室布置，园内的游乐设施等。当介绍到室外游泳池的时候，就听到学生们“哇哇”的羡慕声，纷纷表示印尼的孩子好幸福。再介绍到上下学时间的安排，在印尼，孩子是半天的课程，学生不会在学校吃午餐和午休，这些都是跟台湾幼儿园有所不同的。

第三部分就讲到了幼儿园的华语教学，从华文主题的设定，到华文课程的安排，再到华文课程的设计，都一一详细地举例说明。由于我们面对的学生绝大部分都是零基础开始学华语，而我们不采用翻译式教学，所以每一堂课的设计都要以趣味性为主，吸引学生的注意力，让学生在欢乐中学习。这一部分我们展示了各个主题在中文课堂中的趣味活动照片，展示了学生们提交的视频功课，展示了历年带学生参加华语测试，参加华文比赛的照片。

新冠疫情在印尼持续了一年半之久，虽然现在学生会分批来学校上课，但我们主要的教学途径还是通过网课。所以最后一部分是讲华文教学的网课设计。在每学期开学之前，学生们都会收到来自慈济幼儿园的材料箱，每次上课前，学生都能从材料箱里，找到上课时所需要的活动材料，物品无论大小，哪怕是上课要用到的一颗小纽扣，我们都会完整地打包在材料箱里面，让学生隔着荧幕，也能跟老师一起做趣味活动，享受到在课堂中的快乐。

短短60分钟的讲座，在慈大学生们的意犹未尽中结束了，希望这堂讲座能够让他们对印尼幼儿的华语教学有所了

解。同时也期待日后能有更多的机会与全世界各地的慈济学校互相交流和学习。







The song tribute by our PTA parents have also plucked strings from our hearts. Despite their busy schedules, taking care of their



children and work, they gave their best effort and time in giving us an inspiring song and messages from students.

HPV Immunization

Tzu Chi Primary School commits to preserving students' physical and mental well-being. Prior to the home-based learning period, annual vaccinations were routine. One of them was HPV immunization.

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) is a strand of virus that causes warts, which commonly transmit through skin contact. On December 15, 2021, we invited students to further equip themselves with immunity against HPV. This program targeted primary 5 female students and attracted 71 eager participants. Doctors and nurses from *Penjaringan* health center showcased their expertise in handling young teens and briefed them of the possible reactions. The recipients are eligible to avail themselves of the second dose next academic year.

We hope that with the success of this program, students are reminded of the importance of health. After all, the greatest wealth is health. We send forth our deepest gratitude to health workers from *Penjaringan* health center and school nurses for accommodating this immunization program.

Term 2 Hybrid Learning

After nineteen months of Home-Based Learning, Tzu Chi Primary School opened its doors to students in October 2021. Several health protocols are strictly implemented. All members of the school are required to:

- Put on at least a 3-ply surgical mask.
- Wash/sanitize hands and shoe soles.
- Undergo a body temperature scan upon entry.

The reopening was conducted in phases. A trial was initially carried out with Primary 6 students. Excitement filled the air as classmates interacted with each other in person. Similar sights were also observed when we invited Primary 3 to 5 students in the proceeding phases. As for our Primary 1 & 2, our younger learners, eagerness and curiosity were reflected in their faces

though they looked hesitant. This was their first time stepping into the Primary school's building. Fortunately, teachers displayed their expertise in welcoming students, which soothed the atmosphere.



The *Tzu Chi Pick Up System* smartphone app was introduced to promote physical distancing during dismissal. Not only does it allow contactless verification, but it also ensures fetchers' confirmation through automatic QR codes. Although the reopening process proved challenging, it was a job well done. We are truly grateful for the

collaborative effort shown by various school bodies. We would also like to appreciate parents and guardians who have placed their confidence in us by allowing students to attend in-person learning sessions.



PERINGATAN HARI SUMPAAH PEMUDA KE-93 DI LINGKUNGAN TZU CHI SECONDARY SCHOOL

“SATU TANAH AIR, SATU BANGSA, SATU BAHASA PERSATUAN, INDONESIA!”

Pada hari Senin, 1 November 2021 yang lalu, tepatnya di pagi hari sebelum sesi pelajaran pertama dimulai, momen bersejarah Sumpah Pemuda kembali diperingati di lingkungan sekolah Tzu Chi Secondary, PIK, Jakarta Utara. Ibu Caroline Widjanarko, Kepala Sekolah, diberikan kepercayaan sebagai Pembina Upacara, sedangkan siswa bernama Reinhart Christopher Yong Tanudjaja dari Kelas 12 Grateful menjadi Protokol upacara. Siswa yang menjadi petugas pembaca teks Sumpah Pemuda adalah Adrienne

Latenova Irawan dari Kelas 12 Grateful. Peringatan Hari Sumpah Pemuda ini juga diikuti oleh seluruh siswa dari kelas 7 hingga kelas 12 bersama guru dan staf akademik secara hikmat secara virtual di tempat masing-masing. Kondisi pandemik bangsa dan dunia masih mewarnai pelaksanaannya, sehingga kita melakukannya dengan memanfaatkan kemajuan teknologi dan keberadaan internet.

Dalam kesempatan ini, Ibu Caroline memberikan banyak sekali wejangan, informasi, dan pesan moral yang inspiratif, di antaranya:

- Bangsa Indonesia yang beraneka ragam latar belakang budaya dan daerah asalnya, seringkali membuat bangsa Indonesia sering berpikir dan bertindak secara kedaerahan. Momen Sumpah Pemuda ini mengingatkan kita untuk mengutamakan persatuan nasional Indonesia. Para pemuda, termasuk para pelajar, selalu tampil sebagai pemersatu bangsa, dari Aceh sampai Papua. Siswa secondary sudah selayaknya menyebut dirinya adalah seorang pemuda yang tidak mau lagi dianggap sebagai seseorang yang kekanak-kanakan. Pelajar remaja harus mau dan bangga untuk mewariskan semangat juang para pemuda di masa lalu sebagai pelopor persatuan.
- Seperti kata pepatah: “Di mana bumi dipijak, di situ langit dijunjung” yang artinya kita semua seharusnya mematuhi setiap peraturan yang diterapkan di tempat mana kita berada, tanpa perlu melihat orang lain mematuminya atau tidak. Kita seyogyanya selalu melihat diri kita sendiri terlebih dahulu sebelum menilai orang lain sudah melaksanakan peraturan yang dibuat di tempat kita berada. Pelajar yang terhormat adalah seseorang yang selalu waspada dengan memikirkan terlebih dahulu sebelum bertindak.
- Pada akhirnya kita akan merasakan kedamaian yang sejati ketika setiap orang

mau dan terpanggil secara sukarela mematuhi peraturan. Setiap orang termasuk para pelajar remaja, jangan melaksanakan peraturan karena takut dihukum atau karena orang lain, namun harus selalu bangga dan terpacu menjadi teladan dalam menegakkan persatuan dalam menegakkan peraturan. Dalam kondisi seperti inilah, maka kita akan mampu menciptakan bangsa yang maju, harmonis, dan dipandang terhormat di masa depan.



Peringatan Hari Sumpah Pemuda ke-93 ini selanjutnya diisi dengan penampilan kolaboratif yang apik oleh beberapa siswa, yakni: Hans Tengkonu, siswa Kelas 12 Grateful (pianis), Calvin, siswa Kelas 11 Grateful (vokalis), dan Rachiele Aurelia Winsen, siswi Kelas 9 Harmony (vokalis). Di bawah bimbingan guru Musik mereka yang piawai, yakni Pak Mario Sipayung, mereka menyanyikan lagu nasional Bangun Pemuda dengan mengenakan pakaian daerah seperti batik, baju koko, sarung, dan peci. Mereka mampu menggugah

semangat kecintaan pada Indonesia dari setiap pendengar lewat suara merdu dan alunan piano mereka. 




“为爱而写”慈善捐款活动
