Overview

Tzu Chi Foundation is an international compassion relief organization founded by Master Cheng Yen, a Taiwanese Buddhist nun in 1966. As one of the largest international humanitarian and non-governmental organizations with over 10 million volunteers in almost 50 countries, it has also been awarded a special consultative status by the United Nations Economic and Social Council (UNESCO). One of the four major missions of the Tzu Chi Foundation is educational development.

Tzu Chi School in Indonesia consists of Early Childhood, Primary and Secondary School that is located in Pantai Indah Kapuk, Jakarta Utara. Tzu Chi School's Secondary division was accredited by the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme in July 2016. As a young, yet fast growing school, the school will be graduating around 150 – 200 students per year.

The balance between academic rigor delivered using International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Programme (MYP), Diploma Programme (DP) as well as building students' IB Learner Profiles through Ren Wen (universal moral values) is what set Tzu Chi School apart from other IB Schools. The importance of service to community and perseverance of nature have been an integral part of the school culture, and being showcased in the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) program.

Curriculum & Subjects

As an IB World School, Tzu Chi School offers the Middle Years Programme (MYP) and Diploma (DP). Our Students follow a dual curriculum, combining the globally recognized IB framework with Indonesian's national curriculum to provide a comprehensive and balanced education.

MYP Subjects

Students are required to take 3 languages, Bahasa Indonesia, English, and Chinese in grade 7-10 based on their level.

Students are also following Individual & Societies, Combined Science, Mathematics, and Physical Health and Education (PHE)

Elective subjects are Visual Arts, Digital Design, and Music. Grade 7-8 students will have all 3 subjects and they will have to choose 1 subject during their grade 9 and 10.

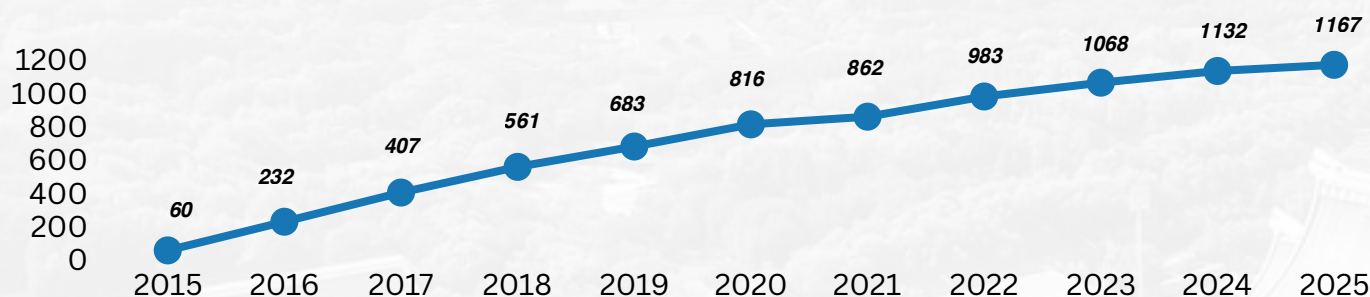

More than 95% of the students are Indonesian citizens. The remaining students come from various countries around the world.

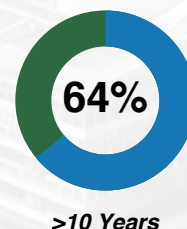
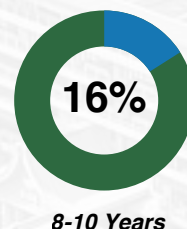
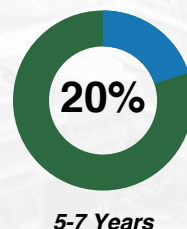

Faculty Demographics

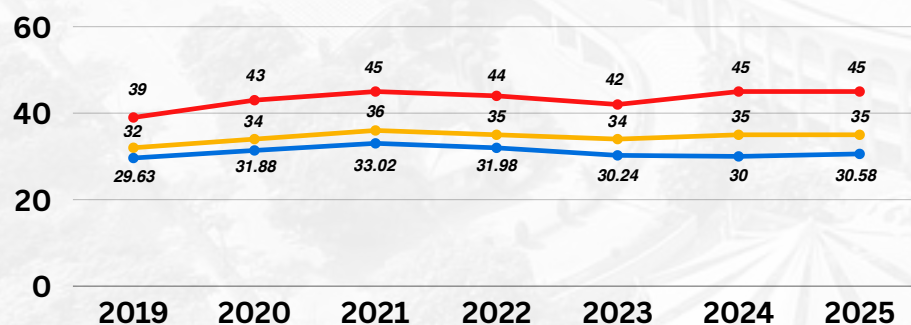
Our Teaching Faculty has at least 5 years of experience. About 16% have 8 to 10 years of experience, while 64% have more than 10 years of experience.
